TEAM POINTS and AWARDS How the Challenge Works

Captains! Thanks to you and your team for being part of our fundraising event. You will be helping Hope Awaits to keep their doors open and continue to see the lives of homeless men restored.

Please read the rules below and make sure that all your team members understand the challenge details. Then your team will be prepared to have fun and win. In order to enter any of the challenges to win and receive top team awards, each team must either collect pledges (\$500.00 minimum) or pay a \$500.00 entrance fee.

Challenge Day Registration

Arrive on time and stop by our registration table that will be located under the marked tent on the day of the event. The registration table will open at 11:00 a.m. and all team members are to be checked in by 11:30 a.m. Each participant is required to fill out a registration form and sign an event waiver, and if under the age of 18, the waiver needs to be signed by a parent/guardian. There must be one responsible team member over the age of 18 per team. Waiver forms, pledge forms and posters will be provided to each team captain for their team members. Team Challenges and Award

There will be three different challenges that will give teams the opportunity to win team honours and have the team name added to our annual plaques.

1. The team who raises the most money in donations will have their team name added to our Annual Fundraising Plaque.
2. The Team Shelter Building Plaque will be awarded to the team who is judged to have constructed the best shelter while following the shelter building rules and regulations. Please see the details on the reverse of this page.
3. Team Participation Award will be awarded to the team that earns the most points which are earned for various team activities. See activities and point details listed on the reverse of this page.

How to Earn Points and Win The Award for Top Team Participation

<p>Challenge a Team Points will be awarded to teams who challenge another team. There is no limit to the number of teams you can challenge but they must raise pledges and participate in the event.</p>	<p>+2000 points for each team you challenge that raises funds and participates.</p>
<p>Shelter Teams are to supply their own shelter materials and are to build a shelter that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Is free standing ● Is large enough to fit all team members ● Is built only using the allowed materials listed below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Cardboard, Newspaper, Tarps ○ Plastic, Garbage Bags ○ String and/or Tape ○ Cannot be attached to a fence or tree and stakes cannot be driven into the ground <p>Teams are required to dismantle and remove all shelter materials from the site at the end of the event.</p>	<p>Points will be awarded for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sticking to the materials - Number of materials used - Originality - Weather resistance - How many members can fit in your shelter
<p>Food Donations Non-perishable food will be collected. Certain non-perishable food items will earn your team more points! These select items are used in Hope Awaits' care packages that are given to anyone in need that comes to the shelter doors.</p>	<p>+40 points for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Granola Bars - Apple Sauce Cups - Juice Boxes - Bottled Water <p>+20 points for any other non-perishable item</p>
<p>Team Games and Awareness Activities Each team will participate in various games and activities throughout the event.</p>	<p>Points will be awarded for each game or activity completed.</p>
